**(501MAE) MACAU EXCURSION - Morning Town Ride**

Duration: Approx. 10 hours (not include hotel pick up time)

Same as Hong Kong, Macau is a place where the East meets West. In this tour, you will be shown the charm of the Chinese and Portuguese heritages embraced in arrays of modernized architecture. After hotel pick up, transfer to Macau Ferry Terminal for departure to Macau. Upon arrival, sightseeing tour begins with certain World Heritages including Na Tcha Temple, Section of the Old City Walls, Mount Fortress and the landmark of Macau – Ruins of St. Paul's Roman Catholic Church. This Roman Catholic Church was built in 1602 and burned by fire in 1835. Miraculously, fine art of carvings and statues can be seen on the surviving facade.



**NA TCHA TEMPLE (WORLD HERITAGE)**

This Chinese traditional style temple called Na Tcha Temple which was built for worshipping Na Tcha (a mythical character). This temple has become a World Heritage in 2005.

**SECTION OF THE OLD CITY WALLS (WORLD HERITAGE)**

This surviving segment of City Wall was built in 1569. It is a remnant of an early Portuguese tradition of constructing defensive walls around their port settlements. It has become a World Heritage in 2005.

**MUSEUM OF MACAU**

The Museum of Macau, exhibits Macau's history, people and culture, emphasizing the bi-culture of the place. (N.B. Museum of Macau is closed on Monday. It will be replaced by visiting Maritime Museum.)

**MOUNT FORTRESS (WORLD HERITAGE)**

The fortress was Macau's principal military defense structure which was built conjunction with the Jesuits form 1617 to 1626. The fortress covers an area of 10,000 square metres and in the shape of a trapezoid. It has become a World Heritage in 2005.



**TEMPLE OF A-MA (WORLD HERITAGE)**

The temple was built 400 years ago in homage to a girl who saved seamen's life. Macau was later named by the Portuguese settlers in mid-16th Century. This temple has become a World Heritage in 2005.

**MACAU TOWER**

Soar to a breathtaking 223M above ground and marvel at the lounge. Gaze out over Taipa and Coloane. Look for Macau's landmarks and historical sites. Or try to spot Hong Kong's outlying Islands.

### FULL DAY MACAU TOUR (KSMAC)

Duration: Approx. 10 hours  
Daily Morning Departure  
Hotel pick-up time: 7:15 am - 8:30 am  
(Actual time will be given at the time of reservation)

The name "Macau", is derived from the name of a Chinese goddess popular with seafarers and fishermen, known as A-Ma or Ling Ma. Macau is a Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China since 20 December, 1999 and will maintain its social and economical characteristics in accordance to the principle of "One country, two systems." This is a full-day tour including lunch and will introduce you to the traditional attractions of Macau.



### RUINS OF ST. PAUL'S

A 16th century complex in Macau including of what was originally St. Paul's College and the **Cathedral of St. Paul** also known as "Mater Dei", a 17th century Portuguese cathedral dedicated to Saint Paul the Apostle. Today, the ruins are one of Macau's most famous landmarks. In 2005, they were officially enlisted as part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site, Historic Centre of Macau.



### STATUE OF KUN IAM

Located on the Outer Harbour, this statue, dedicated to Goddess of Kun Iam (Goddess of Mercy) is 20 meters tall and made of special bronze. The dome shaped base resembles a lotus flower, an ecumenical centre where information is available on Buddhism, Taoism and Confucianism.



### SENADO SQUARE

The 3700m, Leal Senado Square is paved with a wave-patterned mosaic of coloured stones, created by Portuguese experts.



### MACAU TOWER

Opened officially on 19th December 2001, the Macau Tower Convention & Entertainment Centre (MTCEC) comprises of a communications and observation Tower, a 4-level Convention & Entertainment Centre and a 2-level underground basement, as well as an Outdoor Plaza. Please note there is an entry fee to enter the Observation Tower at the top of the Macau Tower, if you are interested (at own expense)



### KUN IAM TEMPLE

This Buddhist temple dedicated to the Goddess of Mercy was founded in the 13<sup>th</sup> century and the present buildings date from 1627. It is one of the biggest and wealthiest of Macau's temples with a huge entrance gate and roofs clustered with porcelain figures.

**SHEKOU** is located in the southern part of Nantau Peninsula, and an important part of Shenzhen which is named the first Special Economic Zone of China. Nowadays SHEKOU has become one of the city's major scenic spots drawing for tourists. Highlights include:



**KINDERGARTEN**

Enjoy the unusual experience of visiting a local kindergarten. (Closed on Saturdays, Sundays and school holidays. Tour will visit "THE LEGEND OF NUWA" instead.)



**FREE MARKET**

Visit one of the free markets in SHEKOU, have an insight of local people's bargaining power in food markets.



**MINERAL MUSEUM**

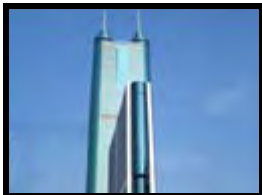

Window of the World is one of the most famous tourist destinations in Shenzhen. The park covers an area of 480,000 m2 and is divided into the World Square, Asia Area, Oceania Area, Europe Area, North America Area, World Sculpture Park and International Street. Window of the World shows the Worlds key points of interest, natural scenes, world wonders, folk' housing, sculpture etc; totally more than 130 scenic spots. There are also entertainment programs. When you walk along the street, you can clearly see a miniature version of the Eiffel tower in the park and the International street with the hotels in foreign styles.



**WINDOW OF THE WORLD - TAJ MAHAL**

Taj Mahal truly looks like the white marble tomb of Agra. The colors and details on the doors and pinnacles were well designed. It is one of the most popular spots in the park.

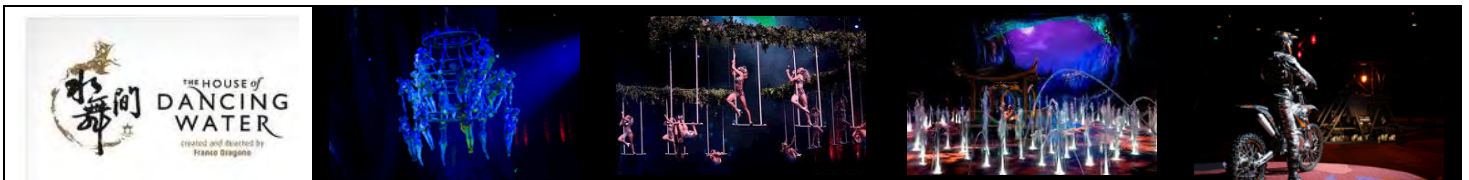

### **SECTION OF THE OLD CITY WALLS (WORLD HERITAGE)**

This surviving segment of City Wall was built in 1569. It is a remnant of an early Portuguese tradition of constructing defensive walls around their port settlements. It has become a World Heritage in 2005.



### **MUSEUM OF MACAU**

The Museum of Macau, exhibits Macau's history, people and culture, emphasizing the bi-culture of the place.

(N.B. Museum of Macau is closed on Monday. It will be replaced by visiting Maritime Museum.)



### **MOUNT FORTRESS (WORLD HERITAGE)**

The fortress was Macau's principal military defense structure which was built in conjunction with the Jesuits from 1617 to 1626. The fortress covers an area of 10,000 square metres and in the shape of a trapezoid. It has become a World Heritage in 2005.



### **TEMPLE OF A-MA (WORLD HERITAGE)**

The temple was built 400 years ago in homage to a girl who saved seamen's life. Macau was later named by the Portuguese settlers in mid-16th Century. This temple has become a World Heritage in 2005.



### **MACAU TOWER**

Soar to a breathtaking 223M above ground and marvel at the lounge. Gaze out over Taipa and Coloane. Look for Macau's landmarks and historical sites. Or try to spot Hong Kong's outlying Islands.



### **CASINO**

Casinos in Macau offer a large variety of casino games that give versatile entertainment to visitors. Try your luck!

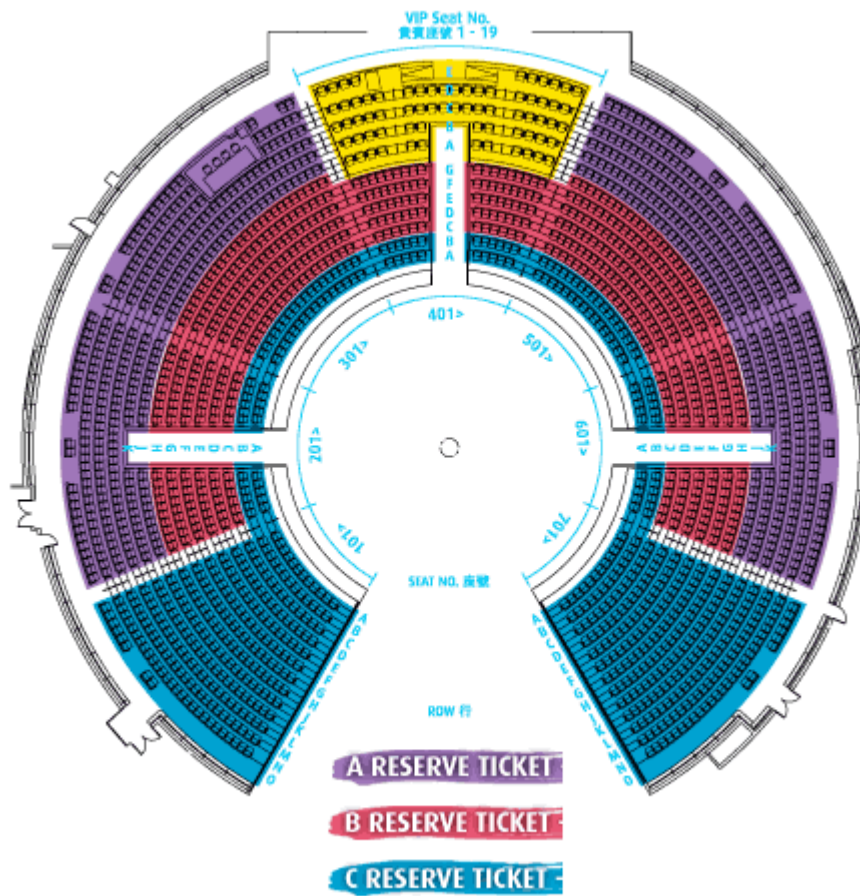

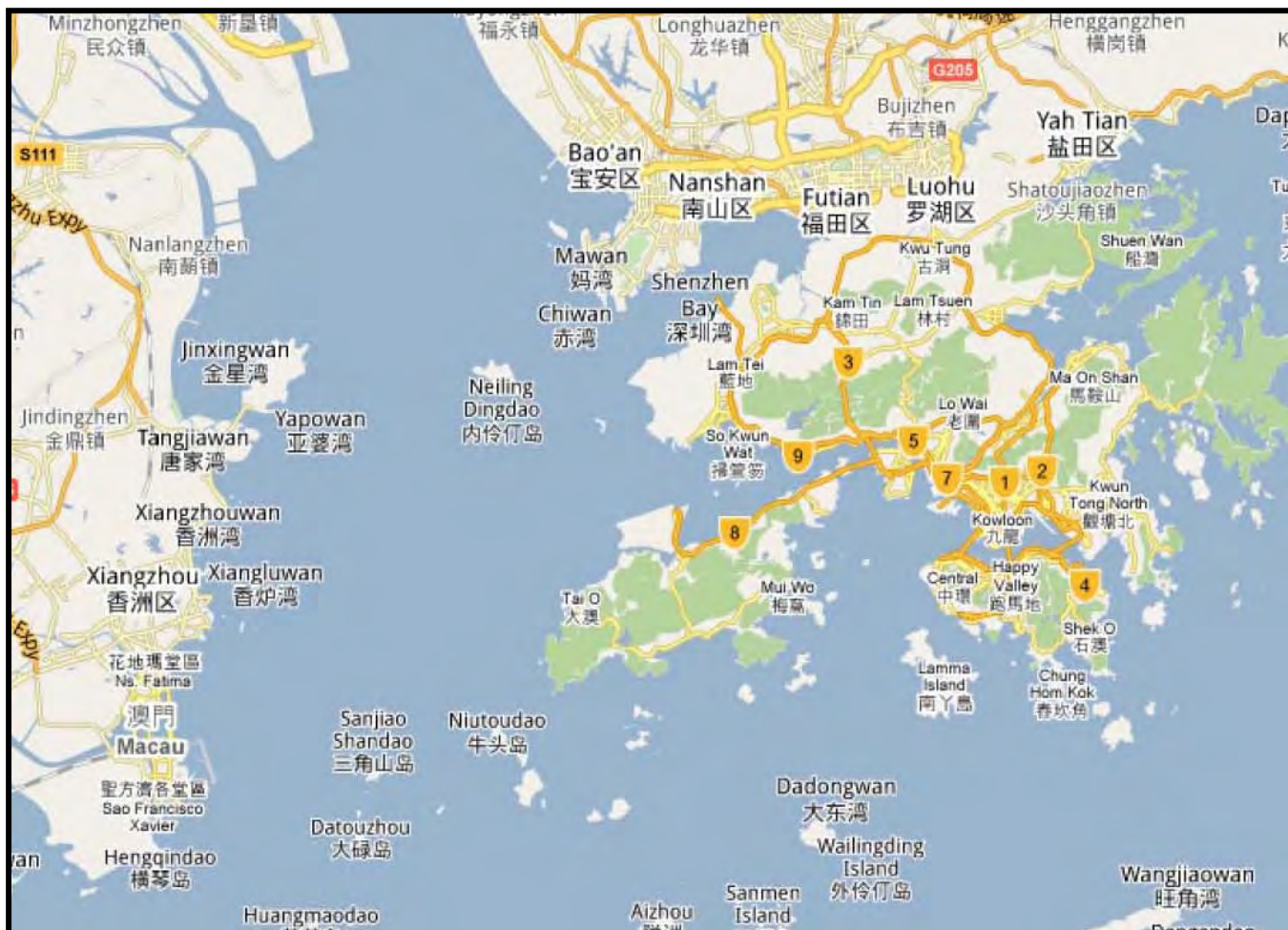
