Duration: Approx. 10 hours (not include hotel pick up time)

Daily Morning Departure Hotel pick-up time: 7:00 am - 7:30 am

Same as Hong Kong, Macau is a place where the East meets West. In this tour, you will be shown the charm of the Chinese and Portuguese heritages embraced in arrays of modernized architecture. After hotel pick up, transfer to Macau Ferry Terminal for departure to Macau. Upon arrival, sightseeing tour begins with certain World Heritages including Na Tcha Temple, Section of the Old City Walls, Mount Fortress and the landmark of Macau – Ruins of St. Paul's Roman Catholic Church. This Roman Catholic Church was built in 1602 and burned by fire in 1835. Miraculously, fine art of carvings and statues can be seen on the surviving facade.



NA TCHA TEMPLE (WORLD HERITAGE)

This Chinese traditional style temple called Na Tcha Temple which was built for worshipping Na Tcha (a mythical character). This temple has become a World Heritage in 2005.

SECTION OF THE OLD CITY WALLS (WORLD HERITAGE)

This surviving segment of City Wall was built in 1569. It is a remnant of an early Portuguese tradition of constructing defensive walls around their port settlements. It has become a World Heritage in 2005.

MUSEUM OF MACAU

The Museum of Macau, exhibits Macau's history, people and culture, emphasizing the bi-culture of the place. (N.B. Museum of Macau is closed on Monday. It will be replaced by visiting Maritime Museum.)

MOUNT FORTRESS (WORLD HERITAGE)

The fortress was Macau's principal military defense structure which was built conjunction with the Jesuits form 1617 to 1626. The fortress covers an area of 10,000 square metres and in the shape of a trapezoid. It has become a World Heritage in 2005.



TEMPLE OF A-MA (WORLD HERITAGE)

The temple was built 400 years ago in homage to a girl who saved seamen's life. Macau was later named by the Portuguese settlers in mid-16th Century. This temple has become a World Heritage in 2005.

MACAU TOWER

Soar to a breathtaking 223M above ground and marvel at the lounge. Gaze out over Taipa and Coloane. Look for Macau's landmarks and historical sites. Or try to spot Hong Kong's outlying Islands.

(KSMAC) FULL DAY MACAU TOUR WITH LUNCH

Duration: Approx. 9 hours

Daily Morning Departure Hotel pick-up time: 7:00 am - 7:30 am (Actual time will be given at the time of reservation)

The name "Macau", is derived from the name of a Chinese goddess, popular with seafarers and fishermen, known as A-Ma or Ling Ma. Macau is a Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China since 20 December, 1999 and will maintain its social and economical characteristics in accordance to the principle of "One country, two systems."

RUINS OF SAINT PAUL'S

All that remains of the greatest of Macau's churches is its magnificent stone facade and grand staircase. The church was built in 1602, made of taipa and wood, was brilliantly decorated and furnished. For many, the silhouette of the remaining structure is a timeless icon of Macau and it's former Portuguese influence.



PENHA CHURCH

From this hilltop there are sweeping views of the Inner Harbour and city, the Pearl River, and the islands and hills of nearby China.

BARRIER GATE

Situated on the northern most point of Macau, the stone gate traditionally marked the border with China prior to it's return to Chinese sovereignty in 1999.



KUM IAM TEMPLE

This Buddhist temple dedicated to the Goddess of Mercy was founded in the 13th century and the present buildings date back since 1627. It is one of the biggest and wealthiest of Macau's temples with a huge entrance gate and roofs clustered with porcelain figures.

LISBOA CASINO

The most famous and popular casino in Macau. They offer probably the widest range of games in the world, including baccarat, blackjack, roulette and of course, hundreds of the most glittering array of slot machines. This is one of the original casinos of Macau and the architecture was designed after careful consultation and lots of advice from a Fung Shui Master. Some designs are very subtle, yet some are not as subtle. For example the exterior of the building resembles a Chinese bamboo birdcage, which the local elders like to take their pet birds in, for a morning stroll in the parks. The purpose being that the gamblers, just like the birds, could not escape until the owner decided to free them.

Note: Please remember to bring your passport with you on this tour. Gentlemen wearing shorts will be declined entry inside the casino Tour fees include air-conditioned sightseeing coach, English Speaking guide service, round-trip ferry tickets, transfers between Hotel and Macau Ferry Terminal, lunch at local restaurant

"GIANT'S HOMETOWN OF ZHONGSHAN"

ZHONGSHAN is a prefecture-level city in the south of the Pearl River Delta in Guangdong province, the important waterway that connects Guangzhou with Hong Kong and Macau. Covering an area of 1,800 square kilometers (about 695 square miles), the city was originally a county renamed in honour of Dr. Sun Yat-sen (also known as Sun Zhongshan), the "Father of modern China". Zhongshan is a city of numerous leafy parks, wide boulevards and various monuments. Tour begins at Red Military Museum...

RED MILITARY MUSEUM & CUIHENG VILLAGE

It covers an area of 20 acres, more than 2,000 pieces of military equipments are displayed there, such as China's first atomic bomb, a collection of aircrafts, tanks, armoured vehicles, artillery, guns and ammunition. Former Residence of Dr. Sun Yat-sen. Located about 30 kilometres from Zhongshan in Cuiheng town. This is a two-storey building that is a blend of traditional Chinese and modern western styles. A specialty of this building is that it was designed by Dr. Sun Yat-sen himself. Within the building, there is an exhibition hall, which has display many arts and artifacts that throw light on the life of Dr. Sun Yat-sen.



Cuiheng village was established in the latter half of the 17th century. Situated 17.6 kilometres southeast of downtown Zhongshan. It is the birthplace of Dr. Sun Yat-sen.



"ROMANTIC CITY - ZHUHAI"

ZHUHAI is one of the original Special Economic Zones established in the 1980s located on the southern coast of Guangdong province. Zhuhai's attractive environment and surrounding landscapes help its reputation within China as a garden city and its quality of life. Hence the city attracted millions of tourists a year. Popular attractions include Statue of Fisher Girl, Lover's Road, Meixi Stone Archways and Face-changing show.

STATUE OF FISHER GIRL & LOVER'S ROAD & MEIXI STONE ARCHWAYS

The main tourist attraction in the Zhuhai city is the Statue of Fisher Girl located at the scenic Xianglu Bay along Lover's Road in which is the landmark of Zhuhai.

The Fisher Girl holds a pearl high in the air with both hands, admiring its bright luster that also symbolizes the brightness of Zhuhai. The Meixi Stone Archways is located at Meixi Village in Qianshan town, Zhuhai City. It occupies 126,000 square meters. Today, only three stone archways remain, which were built by Guangxu Emperor in 1886 and 1891 in honor of Cheng Fang and his families. The stone archways are built from granite. It combines the architectural art of the east and west, and has many wonderful engravings.

FACE CHANGING SHOW

The face changing, or "bian lian" in Chinese, is an important aspect of Chinese Sichuan opera. Performers wave their arms and twist their heads, and their painted masks change again and again. Face changing began 300 years ago, during the reign of the Qing Dynasty Emperor Qianlong (1736-1795). The show performs everyday in the Meixi Theatre.

Note: If time permits, you may be guided to visit a handicraft shop to view the local handicraft on route.

(504 SGZ) SHEKOU & GUANGZHOU IN 1 DAY

Approx. 12 hours (not include hotel pick up time) Daily Morning Departure

Hotel pick-up time: 6:40 am - 7:05 am

SHEKOU is located in the southern part of Nantau Peninsula, and an important part of Shenzhen which is named the first Special Economic Zone of China. Nowadays SHEKOU has become one of the city's major scenic spots drawing for tourists. Highlights include:

KINDERGARTEN

Enjoy the unusual experience of visiting a local kindergarten. Kindergarten is closed on Saturday, Sunday and school holidays. It will be replaced by THE LEGEND OF NUWA*. NUWA is the goddess of creation in China and the state of NUWA is also the landmark of Shekou city.

FREE MARKET

Visit one of the free markets in SHEKOU, have an insight of local people's bargaining power in food markets.

MINERAL MUSEUM

Here you can appreciate some hand-crafts products and get more knowledge about geologic mineral. In the museum, you can see the World famous Terra-cotta warriors; these priceless relics have been loaned from the famous excavation site in Xian. Itinerary may be changed subject to actual traffic condition.



*THE LEGEND OF NUWA is one the First Chinese Gods with a lower body of dragon.

Her most famous Myth is she was in charge of marking humans, so she got clay and began to hand mold the humans out of clay.

GUANGZHOU is the capital city of Guangdong Province and the largest city in Southern China with a population of over 10 million. Its beautiful gardens, long history of culture, numerous historic relies and unique 'Guangzhou-style' cuisine, have contributed to its status as one of the most famous tourist centers of China. Following are the highlighted scenic spots worth exploring;

DR. SUN YAT-SEN'S MEMORIAL HALL

Built in 1931 with funds donated by patriotic overseas Chinese and local people, this beautiful memorial theatre is used for rallies and cultural performances.



TEMPLE OF THE SIX BANYAN TREES

This Buddhist temple owes its name to the Banyan trees that once flourished in its courtyards during the 12 century.

CHEN CLAN ACADEMY

This ancient complex was served as the hall for ancestor worship. It is now listed as an important historical site under state protection.

JADE SHROUD WITH SILK THREAD

Visit the Western Han Tomb of the Nanyue King. The tomb master was wearing a garment made of jade pieces which was the earliest one discovered in China so far.

GREEN GREAT WALL MANGROVE

Futian Mangrove Natural Protection Area is the first and only one country level urban natural protection area in China at present, This is China's largest area of mangrove, and owns unique ecological tourism resources integrating woods, birds, water, fishes and beaches as a whole.



MINERAL MUSEUM

Here you can appreciate some hand-crafts products and get more knowledge about geologic mineral. In the museum, you can see the World famous Terra-cotta warriors, these priceless relics have been loaned from the famous excavation site in Xian.

After visiting the mineral museum, we will carry on our journey to the east coast of Shenzhen, having lunch in a famous Chinese Restaurant as well as spending the rest of the day at the latest tourist attraction – OCT East.

OCT East (Overseas Chinese Town), it is a lately opened eco-tourism park to be marked as a cultural natural tourist attraction intended to bring urbanities back to the nature. The eco-tourism park is beautifully divided and designed into three conceptual zones: Knight Valley, Tea Stream Valley and Wind Valley. These areas combine multiple culture-tour functions such as ecological living, leisure & holiday and outdoor activities. In this tour, we will primarily focus on visiting the "Tea Stream Valley" which is a zone integrated by eastern and western culture and characterized by tea, zen, flower and bamboo.

INTERLAKEN ROYAL PARADE

When the bagpipes suite breakthroughs the silence of the old town, you will meet the royal guards in grand costumes, live pipers marching down through the town and cavalcade you may not find elsewhere in China. This festive celebration will surely delights you!



LION DANCE

Lion Dance is often associated with the bringing of luck and blessings. Traditionally, Lion Dance show is exclusively to be performed in celebrations of major Chinese festivals. Now you can experience this spectacular performance daily thus a better understanding to Chinese culture.

ANCIENT TEA TOWN

This is a place to appreciate tea culture, as well as an elegant site for relaxation. You may indulge in tea meal, tea & pastry, tea & drama, or try the local dish and taste some tea liquor. In this way, you get to know in-deep knowledge of tea & zen culture.

TEA SHOW

Tea Show is a large-scale multi-media sound and image performance themed on tea and zen culture. It integrates the outdoor waterfall scene with the indoor stage performance to

bring forth a dynamic effect.

The area began the "great leap forward" in 1979 when the People's Government declared Shenzhen County a Special Economic Zone. Nowadays Shekou has become one of the city's major scenic spots drawing for tourists. There are many places of Chinese culture and historic ruins to be discovered. Spend a day in Shekou of Shenzhen will definitely make you exciting trip in the Orient more perfect.
